In an effort to provide instruction to our students during a district closure, we will use teacher Planbook links from the Kenesaw Public Schools website to communicate lesson plans and instructional materials to students.

Depending on the circumstances, we will provide an opportunity for teachers to distribute materials to students and their families if education resources need to be in the hands of students.

It is the expectation of Kenesaw Public Schools that students complete work and assignments during an extended school closure. Students will be held accountable for all work assigned. The focus will be on core classes, however there may be some assignments in elective courses.

Plan

To access Planbook: Go to the Kenesaw Public Schools website and scroll to the bottom of the page. Click on the link labeled Lesson Plans. Click on your teacher's name to access their planbook. The lesson plans will outline the subject and required content/activity.

Preschool and Elementary

Students will use consumable materials and textbooks for some of their lessons.

Preschool students will receive activity information from their teachers.

K-3 Elementary students will receive instruction on reading and math through a variety of resources that will be linked through Planbook lessons on our website.

4-6 Elementary students will receive instruction on reading, math, and science through a variety of resources that will be linked through Planbook lessons on our website.

Junior High and High School (7-12)

All student assignments will be posted on the school's website. See the instructions above to access lesson plans. Following those instructions will take the student to each of the teacher's lesson plans via Planbook. Instructional materials, videos, assignments, quizzes and tests can be accessed through Schoology.
