An exciting time is just around the corner...your little one will soon be starting Kindergarten and we are so excited to have them here at Kenesaw Public Schools! Rest assured, Kenesaw Public has a great faculty and staff and will take wonderful care of your child.

To make the process of starting school as smooth as possible and for your child's health and safety, there are a few items we will need before school starts in the fall. These items include:

- Certified Birth Certificate (issued from the state in which your child was born)
- Up-to-date immunization record meeting Nebraska School Enrollment Requirements
- Physical Exam (completed within 6 months of starting school)
- Vision Exam (completed within 6 months of starting school)

Copies will be made of your child's original birth certificate and the original will be given back to you for your records. If you don't have any of the above requirements completed as of yet, no worries...you will have until the first day of the 2020-2021 school year to turn them into the school. Records, forms, and certificates may be dropped off at the school anytime during the summer during normal business hours.
