Meal Distribution Plan

Kenesaw Public Schools intends to offer all students enrolled in our school district with a breakfast and lunch. This will include a cold lunch and cold breakfast. Initially, the cost will be the same as our current charges. Breakfast for PK-12 is \$2.05. The cost of lunch for PK-6 is \$2.75 and grades 7-12 is \$2.90. All Free/Reduced guidelines will remain in effect. We are currently completing an application with the NDE Food Service which would allow us to offer these meals free of charge to all students. If approved, we will communicate through our website, Facebook, and Twitter that these meals will be free.

Parents will be asked to complete a survey to determine the need of meals for our district students. Families indicating that they would like to have meals provided for their student(s) will be asked to complete a weekly survey indicating which days of the week and number of meals each day they would need provided. The weekly survey will be available by 12:00 pm on Friday and will close by 5:00 pm on Sunday. This count will assist the school district with determining the number of meals to make. Lunch for the current day and breakfast for the next day will be provided at designated pickup sites. School personnel will support the distribution of meals at each identified location. The pickup time will be between 11:00 am and 12:00 pm. Parents and/or students may pick up meals at their selected location. These pickup sites will include:

- Kenesaw Public Schools – Outside of the Main Office
- Holstein – On Main Street South of the Post Office
- Christ Lutheran School – School Parking Lot
- Heartwell – In Front of the Community Center

Parents that desire to cancel a scheduled meal are asked to contact Amy Nienhauser at 402-416-0321.

Kenesaw Public Schools intends to begin offering meals to students beginning on Wednesday, March 18th.
